CANADA LEARNING BOND

The Canada Learning Bond (CLB) is money that the Government adds to a Registered Education Savings Plan (RESP) for children from low-income families. This money helps to pay the costs of a child's full- or part-time studies after high school.

In collaboration with Huron County Libraries, the DollarSense collection for adults and financial literacy Back Pack Kits for families (ages 3-9 and 9-teen) are available for borrowing.
